ADMISSION PROCESS 2025-2026

GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE APPLICATION :

- Submission of applications should be done through online mode only. There is no need to submit the hard copy of the application.
- The cost of applications including the processing fee is Rs. 100 per UG programme (Rs.48 + Rs.2 + Rs.50 = Rs.100) & Rs. 120 per PG programme (Rs.58 + Rs.2 + Rs.60 = Rs.120).
- Last date for the submission of applications is **TEN** working days after the publication of +2 results.
- SC/ST/SC(A) candidates, including Dalit Christians, would receive free application for **One** programme.

NEW USER REGISTRATION

- New User can register using applicant's personal mobile number, email ID, date of birth. *(Please avoid giving mobile number of internet center or friends).*
- Once registration is done, the applicant is given a User ID (*personal mobile number*) & Password (*Date of Birth*).
- For the subsequent login use, please use the personal mobile number as User ID and Date of Birth (*dd/mm/yyyy*) as Password.
- The same login ID and password can be used to apply for other programmes.

STEP I - ONLINE APPLICATION - PERSONAL DETAILS

- When the applicant enters using login ID for the first time, he/she can fill the Personal, Family Details and Reservation Details (if applicable).
- Once details are filled in, the applicant must verify the same and press '**Save & Continue**' Button.

STEP II - UPLOADING OF SCANNED DOCUMENTS

- Upload Passport Size Photo (file size : 50 kb (Min) - 300 kb (Max))
- Upload Scan Copy of Your Signature (file size : 30 kb (Min) - 100 kb (Max))

STEP III - ENTRY OF +2 MARKS**Instructions:**

- For UG Admission, marks should be entered only after the declaration of + 2 results.
 - For PG Admission, applicants can apply with first five semester (I to V Semester) mark statements, if they do not have VI semester results.
- i. Upload the +2 Mark Statement. If mark statement is not available get an **attested copy** of the +2 results from your **HM / Principal** and upload it. (file size: 80 kb (Min) - 300 kb (Max)).

STEP IV - ONLINE PAYMENT OF APPLICATION FEE**Instructions:**

- Do not attempt a second time to make a payment before verification. In case duplication / multiple / extra payment is made, college is not responsible.
 - Then go to the Login, enter User ID and Password for updating pending payments, if any.
 - Incomplete applications will be rejected.
 - Applications submitted after the specified last date by the Govt. will be treated as "Late applications."
- i. If any applicant is selected/admitted for one programme, his/her application will be disabled for other programmes. (If he/she has applied for more than one programme).
- ii. Once the payment process is initiated, the system will give the **Transaction ID / Receipt ID** and the user has to make a note of the same for any future clarification on payment status.
- iii. **Debit card / Credit card / Net Banking / UPI Payment** can be used for making online payments.
- iv. After completing the payment process, the applicant will get a payment confirmation message and the Application Number.

SELECTION AND ADMISSION

- a) Provisional Selection list will be displayed on the College Notice Board and Website [Admission Portal] and intimated through SMS.
- b) Provisionally selected candidates can download the Application form from the applicant's login.
- c) Parents along with their wards (Applicants) have to meet the Principal with all the necessary supporting documents in original with the hard copy of the application submitted online.
- d) The date and time for meeting the Principal will be intimated through the College Notice Board and College Website [Admission Portal] and SMS.
- e) Provisionally selected candidates should bring the **Original** +1 & +2 Mark Statement (2 Xerox Copies), Transfer Certificate (2 Xerox Copies), Community Certificate (2 Xerox Copies), Passport Size Photos 4 Nos, Aadhar Card (2 Xerox Copies), Certificate for Physically Challenged and Ex-Serviceman / Widows (1 Xerox Copy) at the time of the interview with the Principal.
- f) All the provisionally selected Roman Catholic candidates should bring a letter from their Parish Priest and should also submit the **Original** Baptism Certificate at the time of the interview with the Principal.
- g) Provisionally selected candidates should pay their programme fee either Online through **SXCTN-ERP Mobile App** or **Offline** at the bank only after meeting the Principal. Payment is to be made on the same day before 07:00 p.m.
- h) After making the payment, the candidates should report to the respective office (Shift I and Shift II) immediately.

B.A. Archaeology

B.A. Archaeology is a 3 years undergraduate programme. During their course of education, the students can gain deep knowledge in Archaeology which will help them to prepare for uniformed services and other competitive exams. **Eligibility:** Any Group in Plus Two.

B.Sc. Artificial Intelligence

B.Sc. Artificial Intelligence is a 3 years Bachelors Programme. It involves a combination of study of all areas of simulation of human intelligence processes by machines and the use of data and algorithms. The students can also learn about Natural Language Processing & Expert Systems through algorithms. Artificial intelligence refers to the general ability of computers to emulate human thought and perform tasks in real-world environments.

Eligibility: Any Science Group in Plus Two with Mathematics.

B.Com (Honours)

B.Com (Honours) is a Bachelor's programme which is the most pursued graduation programme in the field of commerce covering subjects such as Accounting, Taxation, Economics, Financial Management etc. It is a specialized programme designed with a distinct focus on specialization in the field of commerce. B.Com (Hons) professionals are in huge demand throughout India and abroad and can get lucrative opportunities to work. There is a boom of job opportunities in the Financial Market, Banking sector, Accounting firms etc. These sectors are growing each day and thus the job scope for B.Com (Hons) graduates keeps on increasing.

Eligibility: 1. Commerce / Business Studies, 2. Accountancy, 3. Economics / Computer Science

B.Com. (Banking and Finance)

B.Com in Banking and Finance is one of the most promising graduation programmes in the field of Commerce. This course is designed to meet the growing demand for skilled professionals in the financial sector. It offers a specialized curriculum focusing on subjects such as Banking, Insurance, Auditing, Accounting, and Finance, providing students with the competencies required for careers in financial institutions, banking services, corporate finance, and accountancy.

Eligibility: 1. Commerce / Business Studies, 2. Accountancy, 3. Economics / Computer Science

B.Sc. Geology

B.Sc. Geology is a 3 years undergraduate programme. It involves a combination of study of all areas of Geology. During their course of education, the students can gain deep knowledge in Geology and some areas of which will help them getting employment. Geology is an attractive elective paper in Civil Service examinations. Knowledge of geology helps students to score in various competitive examinations.

Eligibility: Any Science Group in Plus Two with Physics & Chemistry.

B.Sc. Criminology and Forensic Science

The Bachelor of Science degree in Criminology and forensic Science provides undergraduates an excellent foundation in the theories of crime and criminal justice response to crime along with relevant practical experience in Forensic and Criminological research methods. There are ample career opportunities both in government offices and private firms.

Eligibility: Any Group in Plus Two. Science group preferred

B.Com. Maritime Logistics

As part of this Programme, the students will spend the first four semesters in the campus and during the fifth and sixth semester the students will attend internship. The programme makes young graduates industry-ready and be gainfully employed at various levels in Logistics Sector. The programme is offered with the sole objective of educating/training students in the technical aspects of Logistics processes with core focus on creating managerial skills in Maritime Logistics.

Eligibility: Any Group in Plus Two.

MBA - Master of Business Administration

Since August 2012, XAVIER INSTITUTE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (XIBA), the Department of Master of Business Administration (MBA) affiliated a Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli, and approved by AICTE, has been offering MBA programme in our college.

Eligibility: Graduates in any discipline from a recognised University with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate in the Major and Allied subjects are eligible to apply.

MCA - Master of Computer Applications

MCA - MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (2-Year programme) was started as per AICTE norms in 2000. It started functioning as a separate department as per the AICTE recommendations from the year 2001. It has a well equipped computer Lab. A separate Seminar hall and a library with 4000 books are available for the holistic development of students. We strongly believe in Industry-Institute Interactions. Several students have been placed in various MNCs through campus interview.

Eligibility: Pass in Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years duration with Mathematics at +2 level or at Graduate level with 50% (45% in the case of candidate belonging to reserved category) of marks in the qualifying degree examinations. (10+2 years (HSC) + 3 (or) 4 Years Bachelor's degree pattern (or) 10 + 3 Years Diploma +3 Years Bachelor's degree pattern. It is mandatory that the applicants should have appeared for the TANCET exam.

M.Sc. Data Science

Data Science is the study of data to extract meaningful insights for businesses. It is a multidisciplinary programme that combines principles and practices from the fields of Mathematics, Statistics, Artificial Intelligence and Computer Science to analyse the large amount of data. It is an Artificial Intelligence subset, that deals with data methods, scientific analysis and statistics. Data Science platform reduces redundancy and drives innovation by enabling data scientists to share, code and produce reports. The working knowledge of this course removes the bottlenecks in the flow of work by simplifying management and incorporating best practices. Lot of employment opportunities are available for the students with this degree.

Eligibility: B.Sc. Mathematics, Computer Science, Statistics, Physics and Computer Applications

M.A. Folklore

M.A. Folklore is a postgraduate programme which has a two-tier structure with Folkloristic and Media Studies along with practical components. Folklore, which is defined as artistic communication in a small group, never confines itself within the boundaries of traditional contexts, but travels across different domains of traditional and popular channels of communication including print, radio, film, television and other electronic modes. This course will facilitate the students to have a clear understanding on folklore and culture, and it will also help them to emerge as trained media specialists with human

Eligibility: Any UG Degree.

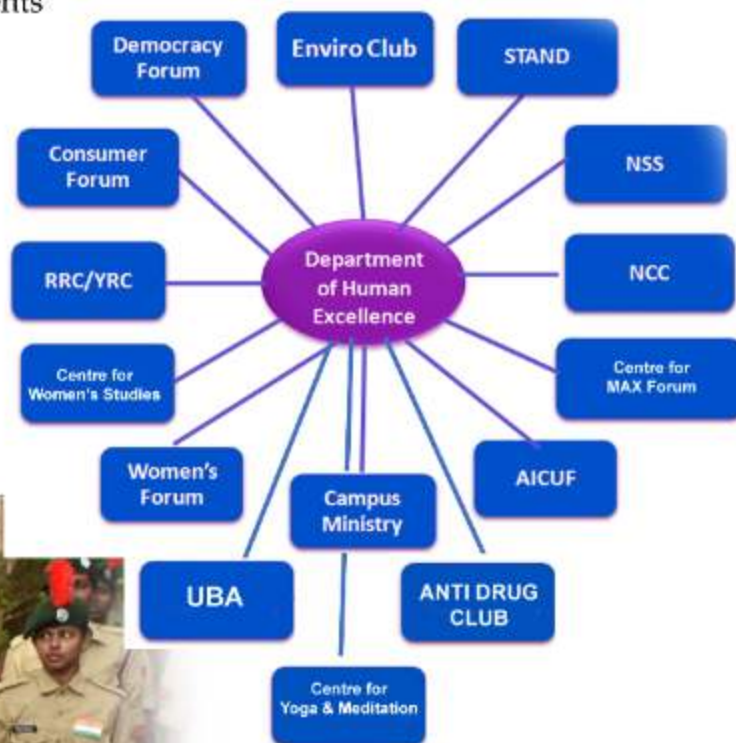

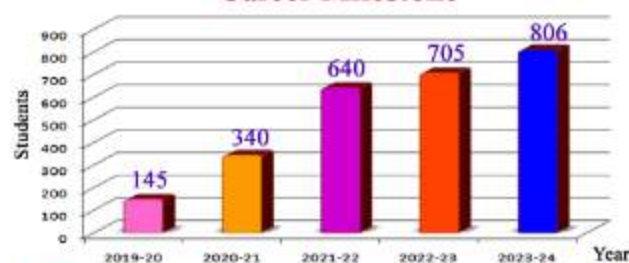
PLACEMENT CELL

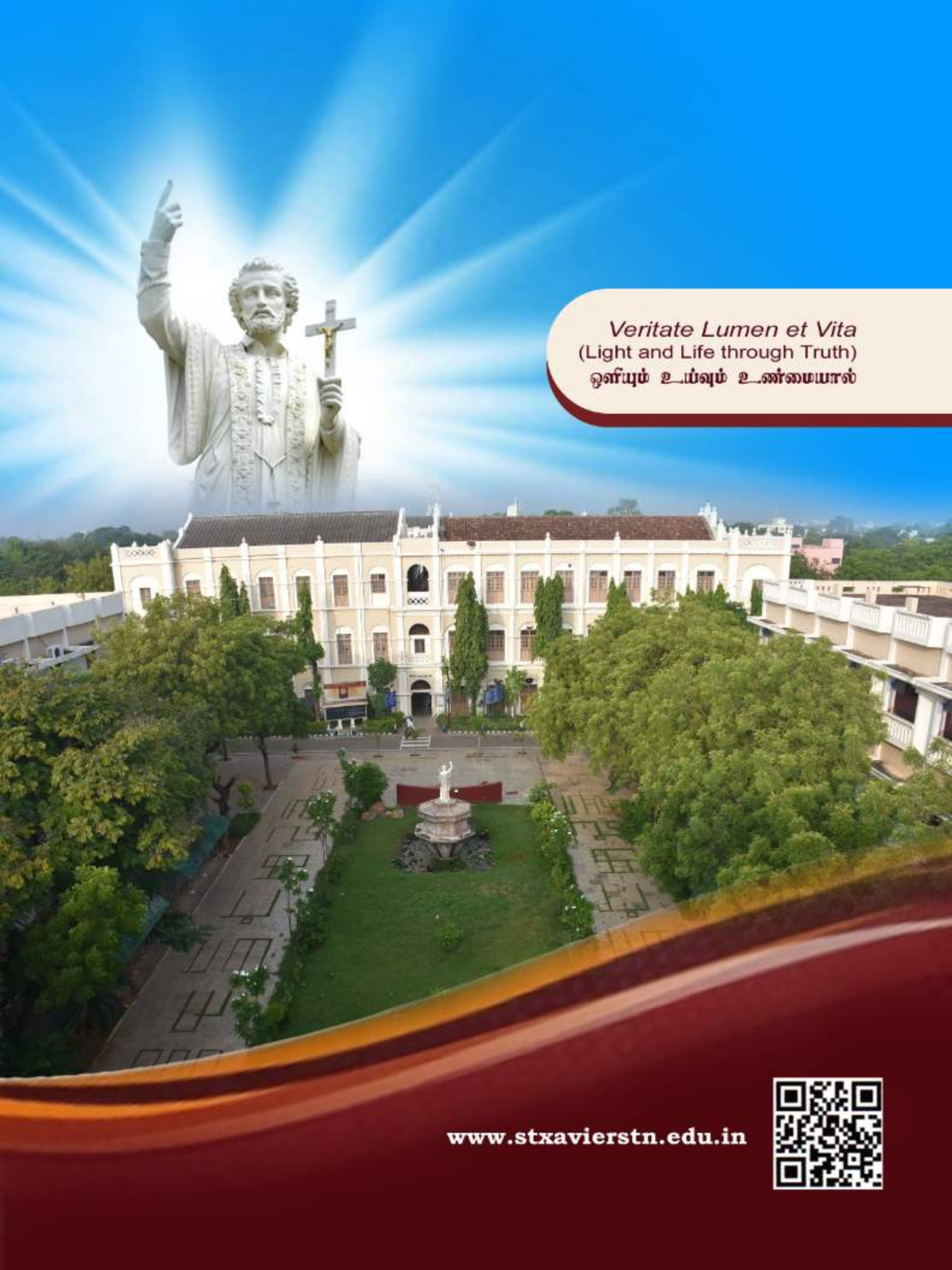
