#### **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. Registration will be done via filling the given form. The form has to be submitted in print and a soft copy in Word File
- 2. A Department can participate in a maximum of **10 out of 12** in Literary Events; a maximum of **6 out of 8** in Art Events and a maximum of **8** out of **10** in Stage Events.
- 3. A student can participate in a maximum of 5 events only.
- 4. The participants should keep up the time. If a participant or a team does not turn up on time within three calls, the organizing committee holds the right to disqualify.
- 5. The dress code should be strictly followed. Vulgarity in words, deeds and movements are strictly prohibited and can even lead disqualification of the particular team.
- 6. Religion / caste / gender sentiments should not be hurt at any cost.
- 7. For any clarification, only the contact staff can approach the organizers.
- 8. Submit a hard copy of the list of participants to the Dean of Students' office and a soft copy in the Whatsapp group created for Contact Staff on or before **DECEMBER 2022 @ 5 p.m.** and send the soft copy to the following mail ID sxcindeco100@gmail.com
- 9. Minimum and maximum number of participants should be strictly adhered to.
- 10. Only the participants are allowed inside the venue (For all art events, staff in charge and students are strictly not allowed inside the venue).
- 11. For participating in events, the individual departments have to take care of the On Duty (OD) attendance of the participants.
- 12. All council members fine arts members & student council members are strictly restricted from participating in any of the events.
- 13. Judges's decision is final and binding in all cases. Any argument with the judges will lead to disqualification. Any sort of malpractice like trying to influence the judges will lead to disqualification.
- 14. The result will be announced immediately after the competition by judges except a few literary events which need time to evaluate.
- 15. No outsiders shall be brought inside the college campus on any account especially for training the students.

- 16. A MVP (Most Valuable Participant) will be chosen on the basis of most points contributed to his/her department and be awarded on the main stage.
- 17. Points system are as follow:

#### SPECIFIC RULES FOR PRACTICE

- **1.** Shift-I students should have the practice only between 1.45 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.
- 2. Shift-II students should have the practice only in the morning between 8.30 a.m. to 1.15 p.m.
- **3.** No practice will be entertained during the class hours and no O.D. will be allowed.
- **4.** Please see to it that regular classes (both Shift I & Shift II) are not disturbed in any way.
- **5.** No department is allowed to bring or appoint any trainer from outside the campus. If it is found then particular department will be immediately disqualified from that event.
- **6.** While the students do their practice, the staff in charge must be present with them.
- 7. The departments are requested to make use of the space available in the college premises according to their convenience for practice. Rooms will not be allotted by the organizing team.

#### **SPECIAL RULES FOR GROUP EVENTS**

- 1. For Solo Singing, Group Singing, Adzap, Short Play, Mime, Folk Dance, Fusion Dance and Quiz (8 Events) audition round will be conducted. Only selected 8 teams must present the same performance during the final round.
- 2. For singing(Solo and Group), a separate finalized audio Pen Drive in MP3 Format must be submitted at the office of the Dean of Students on or before 13-12-2022 by 3 pm.
- 3. For Short Play, Mime, Dance (Folk and Fusion) a separate finalized audio Pen Drive in MP3 Format must be submitted at the office of the Dean of Students on or before 15-12-2022 by 3 pm.
- 4. For Prelims of Dances, Mime, Short Play costumes and makeups are not permitted.
- 5. Kindly note that the Pen Drive contains only that song. You may use a prerecorded background music (karaoke/track) for singing competition. Musical accompaniment may be used.
- 6. In case of change in venue and time schedule, it will be announced in the Whatsapp Group.
- 7. Results will be announced through the Whatsapp group and Student Council Notice Board.
- 8. Change of Participant's names after registration will not be allowed.
- 9. Participants must wear ID cards during participation.
- 10. Mobile Phones are strictly prohibited in the entire event venues.
- 11. Rules and regulations must be strictly followed.
