


Characteristic Features

- Language is
- > Spoken
- > Evolutionary
- Characteristic of man



This imitative tendency forms the beginning of the language

- Elements of Onomatophia
- > eg:whistle



- > Associated with Max Muller
- Primitive speech developed from rhythmical hum or chant
- > War-dance, Medieval ballads , sea-chanties

The Pooh-Pooh Theory

Emotional interjections (pain, surprise, pleasure, wonder)

- Refinement of emotional expressions
- Contempt or Disgust

The Gesture Theory

Advanced by Wilhelm Wundt and restarted by Sir Richard Paget in "Human Speech"

- Natural and spontaneous language
- Sign Language = Spoken language



> Speech is the result of a combination of process

- Printing and Writing are the substitutes of speech
- > Words are the result of analysis, helped by written language
