## PLATO'S PHILOSOPHY

- POETRY- AN IMITATION OF IMITATION
- IT APPEALS TO EMOTION
- POETS- INFIRIOR TO PHILOSOPHERS
- POERTY- THREE TYPES- DITHYRAMPIC, PURELY MIMETIC, MIXED TYPE
- POETRY SHOULD TEACH MORAL PRINCIPLES

#### ARISTOTLE'S PHILOSOPHY OF POETRY

- DEVIATES FROM PLATO
- POETRY IS MEANT FOR AESTHETICS
- NOT A THEORIST/POLITICIAN/POET
- EXAMINES DRAMA AND POETRY SEPARATELY
- THEY HAVE THEIR OWN ESSENTIAL QUALITIES AND POWER

- DIALOGUES, ON MONARCHY, ALEXANDER, THE CUSTOMS OF BARBARIANS, NATURAL HISTORY
- ON THE SOUL, RHETORIC, LOGIC
- EUDEMIAN ETHICS, PHYSICS, METAPHYSICS
- POLITICS, POETICS

- A SHORT TREATISE
- LECTURES DELIVERED TO ATHENIAN STUDENTS
- FIRST AUTHENTIC TREATISE ON THE ART OF POETRY / LITERATURE
- IDEAS NOTED DOWN DURING HIS SPEECH COMPILED LATER BY STS OF LYCEUM- NO COHERENCE/SYSTEMATIC TREATMENT OF THE SUBJECT

# PEOPLE SHOULD NOT FEEL SYMPATHY FOR THE TRAGIC HEROES

- SOME EVIL WILL BE COMMUNICATED TO THEM
- COMEDY- MAKE MEN BAFOONS
- SO POETS AND OTHER ARTISTS- SHD BE BANNED FROM THE IDEAL REPUBLIC

## ARISTOTLE'S POETICS

 ONTOLOGICAL- METAPHYSICAL STUDY OF EXISTANCE

- NOT EPISTEMOLOGICAL(PHILOSOPHICAL) OR AFFECTIVE LIKE PLATO
- BEGINS WITH EPIC POETRY, TRAGIC P, COMEDY DITHYRAMPIC- ACCOUNTS
- MEDIA OF POETRY- LANGUAGE, MUSIC, RHYTHM, METRE

#### SUBJECT OF POETRY-HUMAN ACTION

- EPIC AND TRAGIC POETRY REP HUMANITY
- COMEDY- WORSE TYPES
- POET- A NARRATOR OR MAKES CHARACTERS IN ACTION
