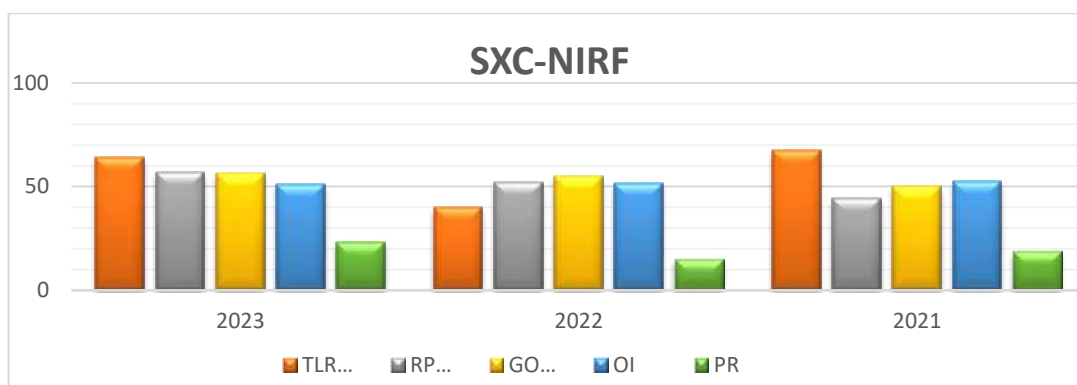

St. Xavier’s College, Palayamkottai, a premier Jesuit-run institution, excels in academics and social empowerment. Accredited with an A++ grade (CGPA: 3.66) by NAAC, the college offers UG, PG, and PhD programs, serving predominantly socio-economically marginalized communities. It is recognized as a “College with Potential for Excellence” by UGC and holds DSIR status for research contributions. In 2023-2024, the IQAC drove key initiatives including faculty orientation, refresher courses, and empowerment programs such as a five-day workshop on ICT tools. Internal and external audits focused on academic and administrative practices, feedback systems, and green/environmental audits. Feedback from students, alumni, and parents led to curriculum enhancements. The college achieved a commendable 55th rank in NIRF 2023 among 2,746 institutions. It also enhanced research output, with 1421 publications and increasing citation metrics on platforms like Scopus and Cross Ref. Collaborations included 10 new MoUs with academic and industrial partners. Value-added courses benefitted 820 students, emphasizing skills in quantitative aptitude and reasoning. The college extended support to neighboring institutions in areas like academic audits and NIRF preparations. Through a blend of academic rigor, research excellence, and societal commitment, St. Xavier’s continues to set a benchmark in holistic education.
